SolBridge allocates a limited number of Scholarships for academic superiority every academic year to *qualified* students.

GUIDELINES

Eligibility:	Students must be admitted to SolBridge without condition, as a regular student. They must have met the Standard English proficiency criteria and demonstrated exceptional academic performance in their last academic experience.
Conditions:	A copy of an acceptable English proficiency test score must accompany this application.
Amount:	Successful applicants may receive a tuition grant equal in amount up to \$8,000 for the first academic year.
Award Date:	Applicants who have been awarded a scholarship will be informed in the Letter of Acceptance they receive.
